

# HOW TO ADDRESS THE LACK OF AWARENESS

#### Lack of financial, human, physical and social capital



#### **DETAILS OF THE SINETRON**

- TITLE Chasing Cita / Mengejar Cita
- DURATION 30 Minutes Daily
- EPISODE 50 + Episodes
- TARGET +12 years / C,D Focused
- AIRING TIME Prime time

#### **CONTENT OF THE STORY**

- 'Chasing Cita' tells the story about 14 year old Cita
- Cita has two older sisters, one younger sister and one older brother
- She escapes forced marriage and sets off to achieve her dream to become a medical doctor
- WAYS TO INSERT NUTRITION (AND OTHER) MESSAGES
  IN THE SCRIPT -> Cita encounters positive role models such as:
  - → Puskesmas Medical Doctor, Dr. Tiara: inspires Cita to become a medical doctor, gives Cita advise on how to best feed the daughter of Cita's sister, Euis
  - → Imam Ustad Soleh: inspires Cita to be tolerant to people of all faiths, teaches Cita about the importance of nutrition to achieve good results at school

#### **CONTENT OF THE STORY**

- WAYS TO INSERT NUTRITION (AND OTHER) MESSAGES IN THE SCRIPT > Cita encounters negative examples and/or transitional characters such as:
  - → Dr. Tiara's daughter Anggun: who steals from the poor, single mother Ibu Ijah Cita tries to help Ibu Ijah and her two young sons
  - → Iroh, Cita's older sister: who forced into marriage against, which was followed by an early and ill-prepared pregnancy. Iroh is very young and inexperienced, therefore she does not provide the accurate care and nutrition for her daughter Euis. Iroh's first child died due to severe undernourishment Cita tries to prevent that the same happens to Euis

#### **CONTENT OF THE STORY**

→ Cita's friend Wulan: who does not manage to pass the exams in school due to her poor cognitive abilities caused by severe malnourishment at a very young age. Because of failure in school, Wulan's only option to support herself and her poor mother is to become a migrant worker. During her time abroad she experiences both mental and physical abuse — Cita always remembers the unfortunate situation of Wulan, which inspires her to work harder to succeed in school and graduate
