

## **ROUTE DESCRIPTION UNIVERSITY HALL**

Domplein 29

3512 JE Utrecht, The Netherlands

### **By Car**

It is difficult to reach the Academieggebouw by car and there are few parking places in the area. There are no special parking places for disabled people in the area.

If you decide to come by car, follow the signs Centrum (Centre) or Jaarbeurs (Exhibition centre). Then follow the route indicated in the below map of the city centre.

The nearest parking garages are on the Springweg or near the central railway station on the Catharijne singel and the Rijnkade.

### From the direction A12/A2

Take the exit Utrecht, followed by the exit Utrecht/Jaarbeurs and Jaarbeurs/Centrum.

You arrive in the centre via 'De Graadt van Roggweg'. Please follow the signs 'P Centrum'.

When you reach the Daalsetunnel (near the railways) please go to the right at the traffic lights. Keep right (do not go through the tunnel) and go straight ahead at the next traffic lights, you will drive under the Hoog Catharijne Traverse. Go to the left at the 'P Springweg', go to the right directly afterwards. Please follow this road and directly after the bend to the right keep following the signs 'P Springweg'. If you have a navigation tool please use the address Strosteeeg. You have arrived at the parking garage Springweg, which is open 24/7.

From the parking garage, we kindly advise you to take the short walk to the University Hall.

You leave the parking garage in the direction of the Oudegracht. Please cross the bridge and go the left. At 'Het Web', please take the first street to the right and you have arrived at the Dom square (Domplein).

### From the direction A27/A28

Take the exit Rijnswaerd and follow the route 'P Centrum West'. Please follow this sign which leads you via the Rubenslaan, Maliesingel and the Catharijnesingel. You will see the sign 'P Springweg' halfway the Catharijnesingel. Please follow this route. If you have a navigation tool please use the address Strosteeeg. You have arrived at the parking garage Springweg, which is open 24/7.

From the parking garage, we kindly advise you to take the short walk to the University Hall.

You leave the parking garage in the direction of the Oudegracht. Please cross the bridge and go the left. At 'Het Web', please take the first street to the right and you have arrived at the Dom square (Domplein).

### **By Public Transport**

Bus route 2, departing from the central railway station, calls at the Dom square (Domplein).

Bus routes 3, 5, 9 and 11 call at the Janskerkhof. It is only a few minutes walk to the Dom square from here (see below the map of the city centre).

You can also walk directly from the central railway station to the *Academieggebouw*. This takes approximately 15 minutes.

It's also possible to take a taxi from the central railway station.

### Pedestrian Route From Utrecht Central Station

Ascend the stairs from the platform to the Central Station hall, situated over the tracks. Please follow the signs 'Hoog Catherijne (shopping mall)'. At the ABN Amro Bank please go to the right and follow the signs to the supermarket Albert Heijn. Go to the left at the supermarket and leave the shopping mall. Follow your road to the left and cross the Catharijnebaan. Then cross the Mariaplaats. At the end go to the right and directly to the left (Zadelstraat). You will already see the Dom church tower ahead. Proceed towards the Dom, take the walk under the tower, cross the street and the Dom square is directly on your right hand side.

### Arrival by Plane

The normal port of entry is Schiphol and the train connection between Schiphol Airport and Utrecht takes about 40 minutes. For a detailed planning of a train journey, visit [www.ns.nl](http://www.ns.nl) (also in English).
